

**ALGER COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
SPECIAL BOARD MEETING**

June 30, 2020

Approved July 20, 2020

Pursuant to recess, the Alger County Board of Commissioners convened virtually via Gotomeeting at 9:45 a.m. on the above date.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Doucette with the following Commissioners present: Commissioners Mattson, Pullen, Rondeau, VanLandschoot and Doucette. Absent – none.

The board of commissioners said the Pledge of Allegiance.

Public comment session was open. There was no public comment; thus, the public comment was closed.

It was moved by Commissioner Mattson and seconded by Commissioner Pullen to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried by the following vote: Ayes – Commissioners Mattson, Pullen, Rondeau, VanLandschoot, and Doucette. Nays – none. Absent – none.

Steve Webber explained that the county policy to open the building will need to be updated.

There was some discussion regarding revenues underbudget.

Chuck Bouth updated the board concerning emergency management and COVID-19 in Alger County and is looking for signage to address current issues.

Nick DeRusha from LMAS noted that now is not the time to let our guard down.

There was further discussion regarding readiness for reopening and the details of doing so.

Commissioner Doucette said that there will need to be a written policy for the requirements of employees and the public.

It was moved by Commissioner Pullen and seconded by Commissioner Rondeau to immediately purchase a sanitizing mist machine in the approximate amount of \$500.00. Monies are to come from the commissioners budget.

Commissioner Vanlandschoot is looking forward to better times. Commissioner Rondeau said the State Police need to wear masks inside the building and that all need to cooperate. Commissioner Pullen explained that all departments need to follow the rules. Commissioner Mattson agreed that the State Police need to wear masks inside the courthouse.

Pam Johnson added that a secure drop-box is on the way.

Chuck Bouth noted that Executive Order 2020-59 requires wearing a mask in public spaces.

Public comment session was open. There was no public comment; thus, the public comment was closed.
