

Ordinance # 15

ALGER COUNTY PARKING ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF ALGER, PURSUANT TO PUBLIC ACT 1945, NO. 58; MCL SEC. 46.201, AS AMENDED, FOR THE REGULATION OF PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLE ON LAND OWNED BY THE COUNTY, AND PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS.

THE COUNTY OF ALGER HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1: As used in this ordinance, the following definitions shall apply:

- a. "Vehicle" means every device in, upon, or by which any person property is or may be transported or drawn upon a highway, excepting devices exclusively moved by human power.
- b. "Parking" means standing a vehicle whether occupied or not, upon a parking lot when not loading or unloading, except when making necessary repairs.

SECTION 2. Twelve parking spaces on the west side of the Alger County Courthouse Building, located adjacent to Court Street shall be exclusively reserved for the public citizens utilizing said courthouse services and parking shall be limited to two hours per vehicle. The twelve parking spaces so designated for public parking are hereby specifically described as six spaces on each side of the west front entrance to the Alger County Courthouse Building. These aforesaid parking spaces reserved for public use shall be so designated by signs. Handicapped employees shall be permitted to utilize designated handicapped parking spaces. Citizens that are not handicapped shall not be permitted to park in designated handicapped parking spaces.

SECTION 3. Any person who violates this ordinance is guilty of a civil infraction, punishable by a fine of not more than \$10.00.

The County Clerk for the County of Alger shall publish this ordinance in the manner required by law, and shall at the same time publish the fact that

complete copies of the ordinance as hereby approved are available at the office of the clerk for inspection by and distribution to the public at all times.

Any ordinance or part of ordinances in conflict herewith are subordinate hereto and this ordinance shall be deemed controlling.

This ordinance shall be effective ten (10) days after the publication of a notice of adoption as it affects the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the County of Alger.
