
ALGER COUNTY RESOLUTION REQUESTING DECLARATION OF THE GREAT LAKES SHORELINE AS A DISASTER AREA AND SEEKING ASSISTANCE

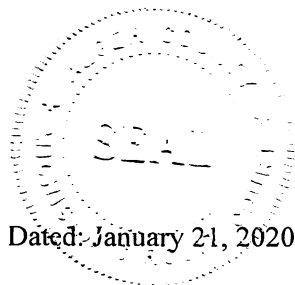
- WHEREAS, Near record high water levels in the Great Lakes, as well as the bays and rivers connected to them, have contributed toward major erosion along highways and on beaches and shorelines all across the State of Michigan throughout 2019; and
- WHEREAS, With the Michigan winter, ice flows and jams will continue to worsen the already bad situation throughout the Great Lakes; and
- WHEREAS, The Great lakes are Michigan's most vital and precious resource; and,
- WHEREAS, The County of Alger realizes that storms, high water, and wind driven wave action are causing severe erosion of the shoreline; and
- WHEREAS, The Great Lakes are the State of Michigan's economic and property value driver for the tax base along the shoreline and connecting tributaries; and
- WHEREAS, The current conditions of the Great Lakes shoreline negatively affects businesses and the tourism industry by limiting access to the beaches; the loss of private property along the shoreline negatively affects the local, county, and state tax base; and municipal water systems and the inland water levels throughout the state are all negatively affected; Now, Therefore, Be it Hereby
- RESOLVED That the Alger County Board of Commissioners requests that the Governor of the State of Michigan along with our State Legislature declare the Shoreline of the Great Lakes in the State of Michigan a disaster area, and that the Governor and the State Legislature seek assistance from Congress and the President of the United States for this devastating situation which has a negative impact statewide.

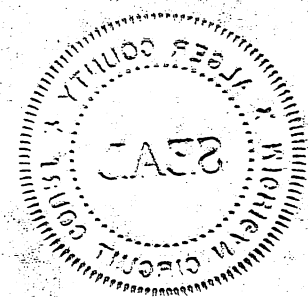
