PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that any qualified elector of Alger County who is not already registered; may register to vote at the office of the City or Township Clerk's Office; the office of the County Clerk; a Secretary of State branch office, or other designated state agency. The Last Day to Register in any manner other than in-person with the local clerk is **Monday, October 18, 2021**.

PROPOSITION FOR LIMESTONE TOWNSHIP OPERATING MILLAGE

Shall the voted allocated township millage rate of 1 mill (\$1 per \$1,000 of taxable value), reduced to .635 mills (\$0.635 per \$1,000 of taxable value) by the required millage rollbacks, be increased by up to 1 mill (\$1 per \$1,000 of taxable value) to the original allocated rate to recover that millage reduction and be levied by Limestone Township for 6 years, 2022 through 2027 inclusive, for general operating purposes? This millage increase will raise an estimated \$7,108.49 in the first year the millage is levied.
